Program Funding: \$1,469,653

Initiative Funding: \$183,171

Refugee and Language Support: \$104,449

Awarded Grant for Indigenous PD-Creating Ethical Space for Educators and Indigenous Learners


- Developed using Indigenous Processes


Addressed Outcomes Measurement and Evaluation (OME) concerns

Adult Literacy Outcomes




ELL Outcomes


